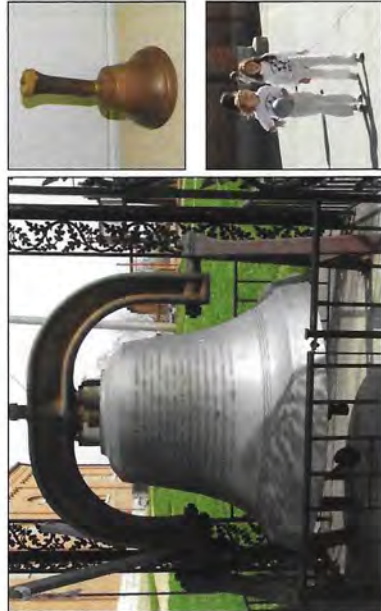

- First school built in 1852

- Completion of new classroom addition in Fall 2013.
